The species was known from the Amazonian forest of northern South America; its occurence in the Atlantic forest of eastern South America was uncertain (Thomas 1976, unpubl. Doctoral Dissertation, Texas A&M University, College Station). First record from Atlantic forest; extends distribution eastward.
